I am sending you this letter to express my opposition to the President's nomination of Georgia State Court Judge Dax Lopez to the federal bench. Judge Lopez has been a member of the Georgia Association of Latino Elected Officials (GALEO) since 2004, an organization that strongly supports amnesty for illegal aliens and seeks to end the enforcement of America's immigration laws. At times, he has served on the Board of Directors and as the group's treasurer.

Both by word and action, Judge Lopez identifies with the philosophical position of this group. Since this organization actively works against the rule of law, and Judge Lopez's consistent participation and leadership have advanced GALEO's mission, Judge Lopez should not receive support from our Georgia Congressional delegation.
