Dear Mr. King:

In response to your request for records, which was received on Monday, June 5, 2017, you requested the following:

“Please send me copies of any/all documents and official emails relative to English education for adults that have taken place that were sponsored or initiated by Bulloch County Schools or were taught on school property. Please include copies of documents that illustrate original start date, number, dates and location of all such classes and total number of adult students and any outside contractors involved in the English classes for adults the school system has operated. Also, please send me copies of any fliers or advertising associated with the adult English language education classes. Finally, please include all application and registration forms as well as copies of the public benefits affidavits required for adult education under OCGA 50-36-1.”

Although the District does not provide any adult education classes, it does on occasion provide limited English instruction to the parents of students pursuant to Title III of the Every Student Succeeds Act. The instruction provided is intended to permit these parents to more fully participate in the education and language proficiency of their children. While it is not entirely clear if the designated documents fall squarely within the terms of your request, they are being provided in an abundance of caution in keeping with the dictates of the Georgia Open Records Act. The information you requested has been retrieved and the cost breakdown less the first fifteen minutes associated with obtaining this information is as follows:

Administrative Assistant (one hour)	\$25.54
24 pages @ .10 per page	<u>2.40</u>
Total Due	\$59.40

With regards to the aforementioned instruction, there were not any outside contractors, flyers or advertising done by the school system. Additionally, there was not an application process, a registration form or any public benefits affidavits because the District did not offer or provide adult education.

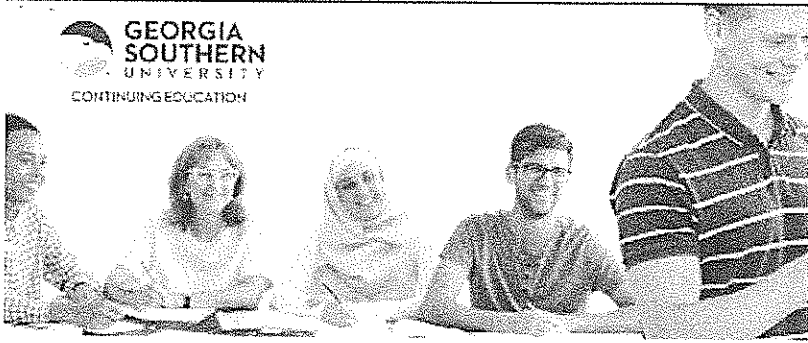
